

Coca-Cola Andina is listed for the second consecutive year in the Santiago Stock Exchange Sustainability Index (Dow Jones Sustainability Index, DJSI Chile).

This index is part of the family of Dow Jones Sustainability Indices and is composed of 26 companies listed on the Santiago Stock Exchange.
